

1. Introduction

1.1 NATIONAL AUTISTIC SOCIETY RAFFLE ("the Raffle") will be operated as a Society Lottery under the Gambling Act 2005 as amended ("the Act").

1.2 The Raffle is promoted by NATIONAL AUTISTIC SOCIETY ("the Society"). The Raffle is conducted for the benefit of the Society and its charitable aims. The Society is licensed and regulated by the Gambling Commission under account number 4729.

1.3 The Raffle is administered by Gatherwell Ltd, Lytchett House, 13 Freeland Park, Wareham Road, Poole, Dorset, BH16 6FA, acting for NATIONAL AUTISTIC SOCIETY as the promoting Society.

1.4 Gatherwell is licensed and regulated as an External Lottery Manager ("ELM") by the Gambling Commission (Account No: [36893](#))

2. Definitions

"Act" The Gambling Act 2005

"Chance" The entry into the Raffle

"Draw" The process by which winners are selected

"Game Number" The six-digit number allocated to each Supporter and used to identify individual Chances which are entered into the Raffle

"Gatherwell" Gatherwell Ltd, the administrator of the Raffle appointed by the Society

"Raffle" NATIONAL AUTISTIC SOCIETY RAFFLE

"Rules" The rules of the Raffle as set out below and amended from time to time

"Society" NATIONAL AUTISTIC SOCIETY which promotes the Raffle from time to time

"Supporter" An individual who has purchased Chances in the Raffle

"Winning Number" The number as explained in Rule 9.1

3. Entry into the Raffle

3.1 The Raffle is promoted in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005 as amended ("the Act"). In order to comply with the Act, during the purchase of Chances you will be required to confirm that:

- (a) You are at least 18 years of age
- (b) You are resident in Great Britain
- (c) You will not buy or claim to buy Chances on behalf of any other person

3.2 If, upon winning any prize in the Raffle, you are not able to prove that you have met the criteria specified in Rules 3.1 (a), (b) and (c) above then you will not be entitled to receive that prize.

3.3 In order to comply with the Act, Raffle chances that have been purchased are prohibited from being subsequently refunded.

3.4 By entering the Raffle, you agree to be bound by the Rules, and applicable provisions of the Act and any relevant regulations made thereunder from time to time. The Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage (including loss of the opportunity to enter the Raffle and / or the right to receive a prize) suffered by you if you have not complied with the Rules. The Rules may be amended by the Society or Gatherwell from time to time.

3.5 Gatherwell employees and their immediate families and household members and employees and their immediate families and household members of Gatherwell's parent company (Jumbo Interactive Limited) and its associated subsidiaries are prohibited from purchasing Raffle tickets and shall be ineligible for any prize.

4. Registration with the Raffle

4.1 You can only enter the Raffle by registering with the Raffle via the completion of an application form which will be published in a variety of forms from time to time.

4.2 Registration will require you to provide the following information:

- (a) Your name and address, so that we can write to you to confirm your entry into the Raffle and contact you if you have won a prize.
- (b) Confirmation that you are over 18 years of age, in order to ensure compliance with the Act.
- (c) The number of Chances in the Raffle you wish to purchase

4.3 You will also be asked to provide the following information:

- (a) Your date of birth
- (b) Your e-mail address

(c) Your address

(d) Your phone number

4.4 You will also be required to provide information relating to the purchase of your Chances. Payment may only be made by debit card.

4.5 Gatherwell shall be entitled to take any steps necessary to verify the above information and to process your registration. The Society and Gatherwell may (in their absolute discretion) refuse to accept an application for an individual to become a Supporter of the Raffle.

4.6 Following registration Gatherwell will send you confirmation of your Chances.

4.7 It is your responsibility to ensure that the personal information you provide to us is accurate.

4.8 If you discover any error in your name, address or any other details provided to Gatherwell as part of your registration, when you receive your confirmation, then you must correct this by notifying Gatherwell in writing or by e-mail. Gatherwell will make any required corrections as soon as reasonably possible. Gatherwell shall not be liable for any loss or damage (including loss of the opportunity to enter the Raffle and / or the right to receive a prize) suffered by you until such correction has been made. Any correction notified to Gatherwell shall only become effective once the correction has been made.

4.9 When registering for tickets, a randomly generated number will be allocated to you in accordance with Rule 7.1 below

5. Payment

5.1 Payment for Chances may only be made by debit card.

5.2 Payment for Chances are made directly to Gatherwell, therefore the payment details on your bank statement will be referenced as payment to Gatherwell or National Autistic Society Raffle.

5.3 The price for each Chance is £1 or such other sum as Gatherwell may from time to time notify to you.

5.4 Your Chances and therefore associated Game Number(s) will not be entered into the Draw unless Gatherwell has received all amounts payable (cleared funds) relating to your Game Numbers for your Chances by 23:59 on the day before the Draw date. If there is a dispute regarding whether Chances have been paid for, then such dispute shall be resolved by

reference to details included in official statements from the bank with which Gatherwell's bank accounts operate.

5.5 Gatherwell may cancel your entry into the Raffle (in its absolute discretion) at any time. Gatherwell will notify you accordingly as soon as reasonably practicable and will reimburse any amounts which have been paid but relate to a future Draw. Other than the reimbursement of any such amounts, Gatherwell shall not be liable for any loss or damage (including loss of the opportunity to enter the Raffle and / or the right to receive a prize) suffered by you in relation to such cancellation.

6. Protection of Customer Funds

6.1 Gatherwell transfers customer funds within 14 working days of receipt into a separate client account on behalf of the societies we act for and these funds are transferred to the Society on a regular basis. All remote operators licensed by the Gambling Commission have an obligation to hold separate accounts for proceeds. This is to protect the player in the event of an insolvency incident. Gatherwell have assessed that they offer a 'Medium' rated level of protection as [classified by the Gambling Commission](#).

7. Game Numbers

7.1 Game Numbers will be randomly allocated at the time of purchasing Chances. Game Numbers may not be amended by the Supporter or by Gatherwell after Chances have been purchased and Game Numbers have been allocated.

8. Changes to Supporter Details

8.1 Any changes to your details as provided by you upon registration should be notified to Gatherwell in writing or by e-mail.

9. Draws

9.1 The Draw process is based upon the random generation of Winning Numbers in each Draw. The Winning Numbers will be selected at random using the online resource <https://www.random.org/>. Random.org is independently verified for their random number generation using atmospheric noise.

9.2 In order to comply with the Act only those Chances for which payment has been received are eligible for entry into the Draw.

9.3 If the online resource <https://www.random.org/> as described in Rule 9.1 is not available on a single occasion then the winning Chances shall be determined in the same way but from an alternative random number generating resource. Details of such an occurrence will be published on the Raffle website.

9.4 If the online resource <https://www.random.org/> as described in Rule 9.1 ceases to be available or is subject to fundamental change which prevents winning Chances being selected, Gatherwell reserves the right to select an alternative random number generating process. Such an alternative Draw process will be selected on the basis that:

- (a) the basic principles of the Draw as described in Rule 9.1 will continue; and
- (b) the basic principles of how winners are selected will continue as described in rule 10.

Any such changes will be published on the Raffle website.

9.5 Gatherwell and the Society are not associated with or related in any way to Random.org.

10. Prizes

10.1 Prize winners will be determined by whether a Supporter's Game Number relating to a Chance in the Raffle matches the Winning Numbers as described in Rule 9.1, 9.3 or 9.4 (as applicable), provided that the Chance relating to the Game Number in question complies with Rule 9.2.

10.2 The Winning Number for each prize will be drawn individually in sequence. In the event that the same Winning Number is drawn more than once in a Draw, a new Winning Number will be generated. Each Game Number shall only be entitled to win one prize in one Draw.

10.3 The prizes available to be won in each Draw will be published on the Raffle website. In the event that a prize is unavailable for any reason, the Society will replace such prize with one of an equivalent value.

10.4 The results of each Draw (including winners) will be published on the Raffle website within one week of the date of the Draw and may also be published in any other manner determined by the Society and Gatherwell from time to time.

10.5 Winners will be notified by email within two weeks of the date of the Draw. Such notification will include a link to claim the prize to the value of the prize won by the Supporter.

10.6 The Society and Gatherwell reserves the right to withhold the payment, delivery or provision of any prize until they are entirely satisfied that the Supporter who has won the prize has fully complied with the Rules.

10.7 There are no alternatives to the prizes offered from time to time unless expressly stated and no interest is payable.

10.8 If, despite our reasonable efforts to contact winners, a winner does not claim their prize, and we are therefore unable to pay, deliver or provide a prize to a winner, within six months after the Draw date, the winner will forfeit their prize.

11. Suspension or Withdrawal of the Raffle

11.1 The Society may (at its absolute discretion) suspend or withdraw the Raffle. In this event, Gatherwell will refund all purchases of Chances in relation to the Raffle that has been suspended or withdrawn.

12. Liability

12.1 Neither Gatherwell nor the Society shall be liable to you for any loss or damage suffered by you arising from:

(a) Any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery methods used by Gatherwell or you from time to time.

(b) Any delays or failures in any systems used by Gatherwell or you to transmit e-mails.

(c) Any failure in any software or other systems used by Gatherwell for the administration of the Raffle.

(d) Any delays or failures in the banking system used by Gatherwell or you.

(e) Any refusal by Gatherwell to accept registration of an individual as a Supporter or the cancellation of a Supporter by Gatherwell.

(f) Any failure to enter your Chance into the Draw.

(g) Any event beyond the reasonable control of Gatherwell.

12.2 Neither Gatherwell nor the Society shall be liable to you in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise for any indirect or consequential loss suffered by you

in relation to your participation in the Raffle (including loss of the opportunity to enter the Raffle and / or the chance of winning a prize).

15. Jurisdiction

15.1 The Raffle and any matter arising from it shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Each Supporter, the Society and Gatherwell irrevocably agrees that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to consider and settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with the Raffle or the subject matter or formation of these rules.
