

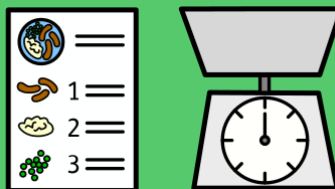
Here are some practical Christmas-themed Maths activities with a focus on functional skills:

Recipe Scaling



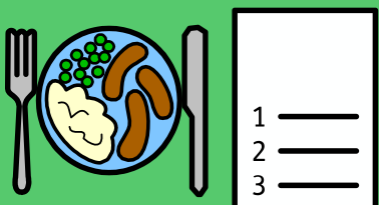

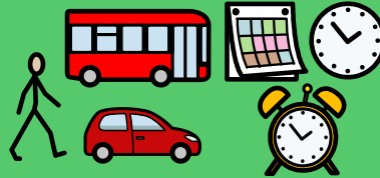
Christmas Meal Planning:
