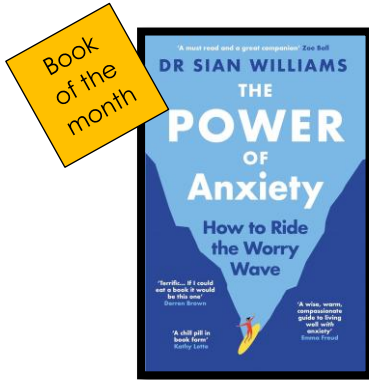


News from Radlett
