Write short sentences with words with known sound-letter correspondences using a capital letter and full stop. Re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense. Use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. Write some irregular common words. Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. Some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible. 			
<u>Reading</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter- sound correspondences.
