

Neptune class spent an afternoon on the farm at Oaklands Farm in St Albans. The pupils were able to get up close and personal with some of the animals










Thank you to the staff at Oaklands College Farm who were so helpful telling us all about the animals. Please don't worry that was not a real lion!


## Makaton:

Trish, one our Lead LSA's introduced some of our pupils to fitness sessions, both energising and relaxing.










# **Sensory Play:**
