I hope you all had a good half term. I thought I would start by sharing some news from school.

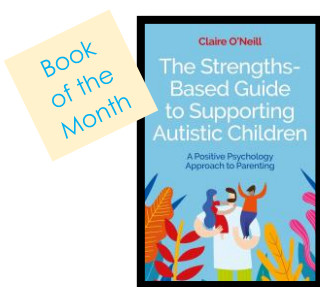
During October we commemorated Black History Month with some fantastic lessons and activities taking place in school.

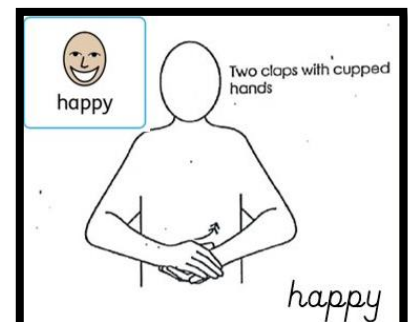
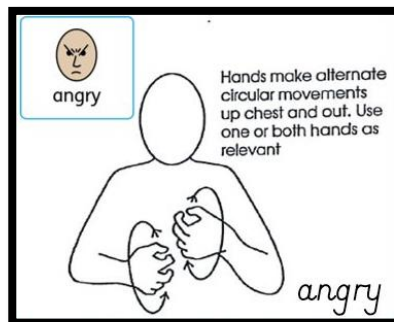
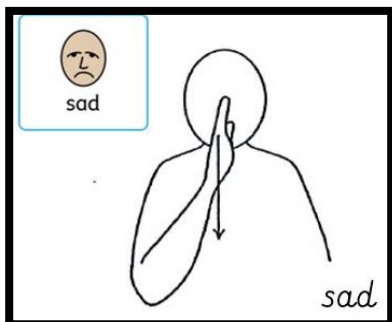
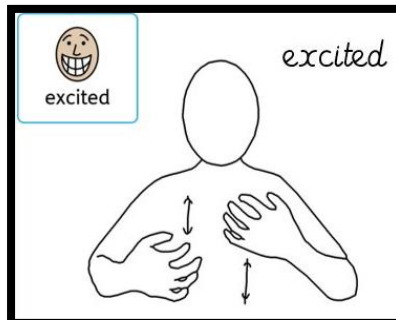


Finally, we have been practised cutting vegetables and planned what we could do with them.
